


## Logistics and Travel Guide for on-site participants of the EUKI Conference “Fostering the Green Transition” 20 – 21 September 2022, Berlin

### The Conference Hotel: Scandic Potsdamer Platz

This year’s EUKI Conference will take place at the [Scandic Berlin Potsdamer Platz](#) (Gabriele-Tergit-Promenade 19, 10963 Berlin). The Scandic Potsdamer Platz is located in the heart of Berlin in walking distance from one of the major train stations in Berlin, *Potsdamer Platz Bahnhof*.



If you arrive at the train station *Potsdamer Platz Bahnhof*, please leave the train station in the direction of Potsdamer Platz and walk down the street Gabriele-Tergit-Promenade towards the Scandic.

Depending on where you’re staying for the night, you might also consider travelling to the Scandic with the underground train (U-Bahn) to *U Mendelssohn Bartholdy Park*, which is located right around the corner of the Scandic.

### Getting around in Berlin

Berlin has a great public transportation system, which is operated by the [BVG](#). We recommend downloading the [BVG Fahrinfo App](#) to explore your travel options, to plan your journeys and to buy tickets. Of course you can also purchase tickets at vending machines at the stations. Please keep in mind that it is mandatory to wear FFP2-masks when using the public transportation.

In addition to public transportation, there are different options for using a cab in Berlin, for example [Taxi Berlin](#) (+49 30 20 20 20) or [TaxiFunk Berlin](#) (+49 30 44 33 22).

### Arriving by train

All major (international) trains arrive at the main station in Berlin (*Berlin Hauptbahnhof*). From there, you can travel all over Berlin using the public transportation system (see above).

If you want to travel to the Scandic directly after arriving at *Berlin Hauptbahnhof*, you can take the Bus (M41 direction Sonnenallee/Baumschulenstraße or M85 direction S Lichterfelde Süd) or trains (RE5 direction Elsterwerda or RE4 direction Ludwigsfelde Bahnhof) to *Potsdamer Platz*. From there, you can walk to the Scandic (see map above).



### **Arriving by plane**

If you decide to travel to Berlin by plane, you will arrive at the airport [Flughafen Berlin-Brandenburg \(BER\)](#).

To get to the city, you can use public transportation. The airport train FEX takes you to the city center in about 30 minutes. If you want to travel to the Scandic directly, get off at the station *S+U Gesundbrunnen Bhf* and use the S-Bahn (for example S2 direction S Lichtenrade or S1 direction S Wannsee Bhf) to *S+U Potsdamer Platz Bhf*. Please keep in mind that public transportation may vary depending on the terminal you are arriving (more information [here](#)).

You can also take a cab (*Taxi*) to get to the city (more information [here](#)) – prices vary depending on where in Berlin you want to get off. Taking a cab from the airport to the city center costs about 50 EUR.
